Department Reports

<u>DPW Superintendent Jones</u> reviewed his written report, a motion was offered by Trustee Hyatt and seconded by Trustee Miller, Motion carried unanimously.

RPL Superintendent Smith reviewed his written report, a motion was offered by Trustee Hyatt and seconded by Trustee Jackson. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Trustee Davis to purchase a new Terex digger truck at a purchase price of \$ 458,795.99 seconded by Trustee Jackson, Motion carried unanimously, and this could take up to two years before we receive it as it will be built for the electric department.

<u>Code Enforcement Officer Wilcox</u> – reviewed his written report. With no further discussion, this report was acknowledged.

Committee Reports - none turned in on time

<u>Mayor's Report</u> the mayor stated that he and the board will create a comprehensive plan committee and will consist of one board member, one planning board, and three residents. There will also be a ribbon cutting ceremony on Friday May 31st during Richmondville Days to commence the high street bridge time TBD. Mer. Sperbeck has sent in a request through email to have sewer relief on a leak that he had, a motion was made by Trustee Jackson, and seconded by Trustee Davis to grant \$316.00 on the sewer portion of his bill, motion carried unanimously.

New Business none

<u>Old Business</u> the Digger truck was discussed during department reports and a motion was passed to purchase a digger truck for the power & light company. Some discussions were proposed on where to use the remaining ARPA funds, pool area was one place or possible for radios for the rpl and dpw departments and will readdress in the next board meeting.

The MVEDD grant has been applied for using NYSERDA grants, we discussed the purchase of electrical equipment for the departments. The board discussed short term rentals that the planning board proposed and will discuss further in next month's board meeting. The board has implemented an employee evaluation to be done on all employees to start in January of 2025.
